A brief template for stories to potential authors for the Quarterly Newsletter

IAWN serves as a global voice of Anglican women, working to uphold the God given dignity of women and girls, to eradicate gender-based inequality and violence, and to promote just relationships among all people. IAWN links women from around the world and is an official network of the worldwide Anglican Communion. We hope you enjoyed the newsletter 'Hope' and are inspired and encouraged by the stories within it. The Steering Group of the International Anglican Women's Network are currently compiling articles for the next IAWN newsletter due out in July 2022. We would love readers to offer your own stories, and/or stories from your church. As the newsletter is aimed to be published in time for the Lambeth Conference 2022, we are hoping to take the opportunity to celebrate women's leadership and the more than 100 women consecrated bishops across the Anglican Communion from Asia, Africa, the Americas, Oceania and Europe. As many of our readers are some of those episcopal leaders, we would love to hear from you too!

We are looking for short stories (not detailed reports) of 700 words, which describe work and ministry in this area in parishes, dioceses, provinces and their wider communities, and the difference it is making. Stories with fewer than 700 words are certainly acceptable.

The story may describe a particular project and how it is making a difference, or it may describe (with an example or examples) how particular circumstances are shaping ministry and calling the church to extend or transform its ministry. It may be a personal story of hope and change.

For some stories, we understand that names may need to be changed in the interest of privacy, in which case, this can be noted, eg: 'Adele, Celeste and Estelle (names changed) are sisters.' The names of children should always be changed.

If acronyms are used, please write out in full, the first time it is used e.g. International Anglican Women's Network (IAWN).

Along with the story we would like to receive:

- at least one good quality photograph portraying some aspect of the story. (Please note we will not use full-face photographs that clearly identify a child or children.)
- a sentence or two about the author, their role, and where they are (eg, parish, diocese, country)
- a contact name and email address for inclusion with the story in case readers would like more information.
